90 Points - A superior California Sauvignon Blanc, filled with vivacious citrus fruit flavor supported by undertones that echo freshly mowed hay, this is a delicious warm weather wine. Dry Creek Vineyard helped pioneer Loire-styled whites in the Golden State back in the 1970s. The winery continues to excel with both Chenin and Sauvignon Blanc (the latter sometimes labeled as Fumé), making delicious, affordable wines that invariably provide a great deal of pleasure. This youthful Sauvignon is one of Dry Creek’s best.
